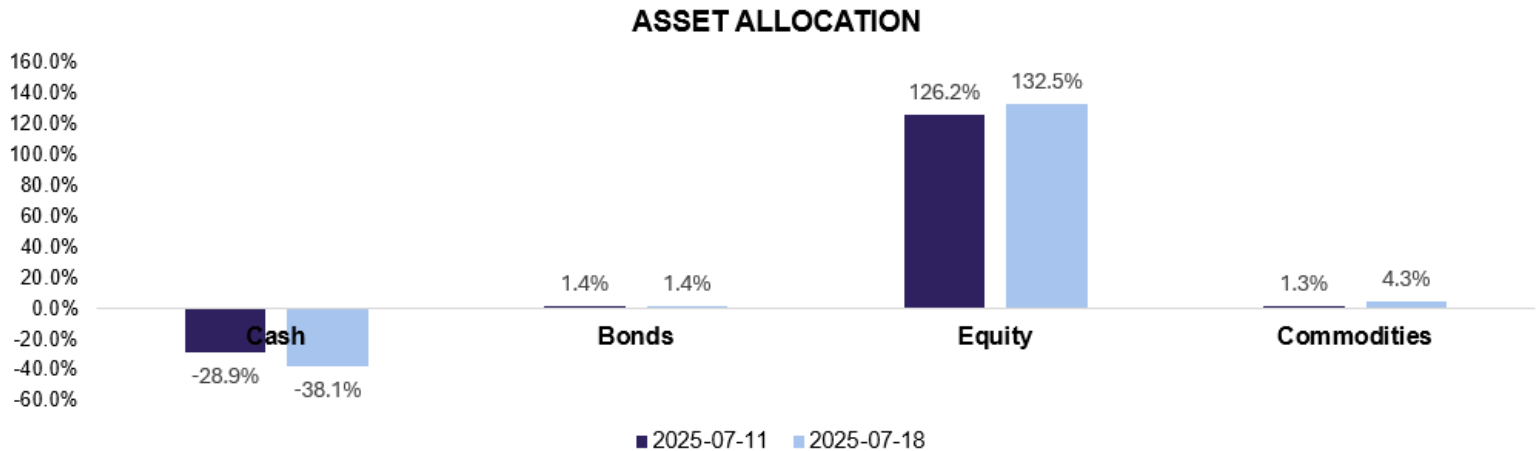

Fund Commentary

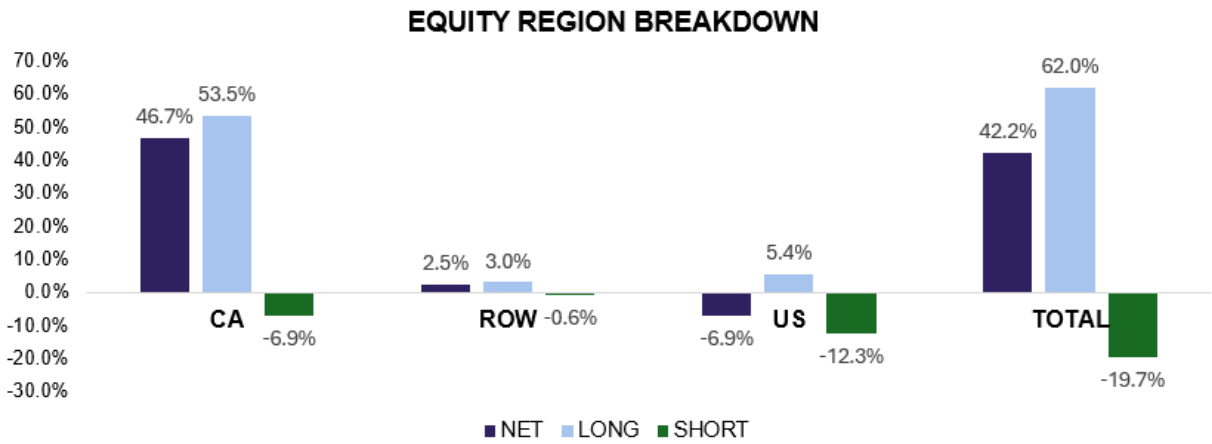
US equities ended the week modestly higher, with the SPY up 0.6% and the QQQ +1.1%, both setting record closes on Thursday. Gains were concentrated in mega-cap tech after the White House unexpectedly granted Nvidia a license to ship its “China-safe” H20 AI chip, igniting a semiconductor rally and raising hopes of trade negotiation progress. A tame June CPI print buoyed sentiment ahead of the July FOMC, where futures now price in no cut. At the same time, Fed Governor Chris Waller continues to repeat his call for a 25bp cut, speaking in an interview with Bloomberg Friday morning.

Mid-week reports surfaced from credible news outlets that President Trump indicated he would fire Fed Chair Jerome Powell. The rumour sparked a market reaction of Dollar weakness, higher Gold, steeper curves, and equity softness before the White House walked it back, indicating to market participants it was likely a “trial balloon”. Higher long-bond yields work against the administration’s goals, and with the memory still fresh of how a previous yield spike forced a

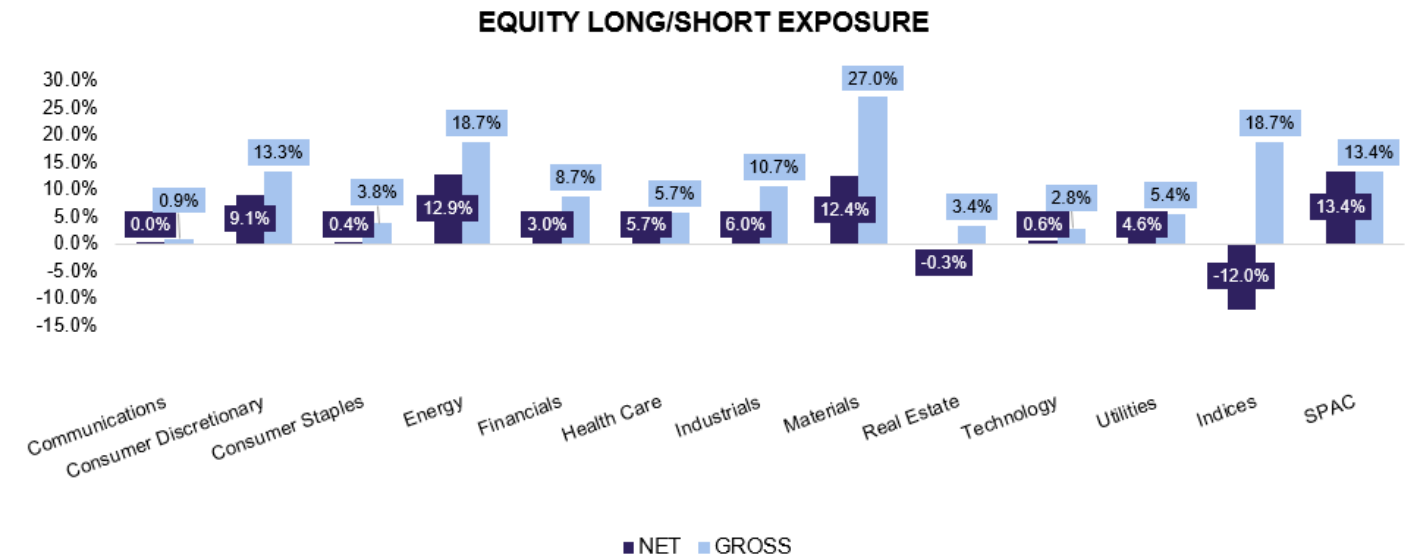
rollback of the Liberation Day tariffs, this episode faded almost as quickly as it began. Although firing Powell remains a low probability, a loss of Fed independence remains an ongoing tail risk to markets. One of the best ways to protect against this is to be long Gold and Silver.

With Fed officials now in blackout before the July FOMC, focus shifts to PMIs on Tuesday and a heavy earnings slate. Roughly one-fifth of the SPY reports including Microsoft (Tue), Alphabet and Tesla (Wed), Amazon and Intel (Thu), creating a tech-heavy line-up that will test the market’s AI optimism. Tariff rhetoric could keep volatility elevated as the August 1st deadline approaches.
