

Fund Commentary


U.S. markets extended their losing streak last week, with the SPY and IWM falling 2.3% and 1.5% respectively, marking the fourth consecutive weekly decline. Persistent concerns about Trump's tariff rhetoric and its economic impact drove early-week volatility, though modest relief emerged midweek as U.S.-Canada tariff negotiations showed progress.

Late last week, we entered correction territory (10% down from the peak). This happened in 16 trading days, the fastest in 5 years, and the 11th quickest in the last 50 years. Could this be attributable solely to the uncertainty from Trump's policy...sure it's possible. However, we believe there were a confluence of interconnected factors in play including positioning (crowded trades), market structure (pod shops), and negative seasonality. This is another reminder that market structure has developed in a way that non fundamental factors have a much larger impact to price action than ever before. This shapes how we employ our strategy and construct the portfolio, specifically in our tactical exposures. Shorter term, we think markets are setup for a tradeable bounce. However, longer term, we believe we may be at the start of a topping process and will be re-constructing the portfolio more defensively over time (which we've already


started).

This week’s economic calendar remains light, featuring retail sales data Monday and jobless claims Thursday. Attention centers on Wednesday’s FOMC meeting, where markets expect no change in policy rates, but will scrutinize Powell’s commentary for shifts in the economic outlook and any incremental changes in messaging (currently June remains the first fully priced cut). Also worth mentioning, NVDA’s GTC Conference (Monday-Thursday) could spark volatility in AI stocks after recent sector weakness.
